## **BURSARY AWARDS INFORMATION**

The Grenada Boys' Secondary School (GBSS) Alumni Association (Toronto) has established a bursary program to assist offspring of GBSS alumni who are residents of Ontario with the costs of post secondary education. The bursary is a one time cash award to eligible students who have been accepted at an accredited university or community college.

### **Number and Value of Bursaries:**

Three bursaries, each valued at \$700.00, will be awarded. The bursaries are one time awards and are not transferable.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

To be considered, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Offspring of GBSS alumni who are residents of Ontario.
- Must have attended secondary school in Ontario or the GBSS in Grenada. Students who attended the GBSS must be Canadian landed immigrants or citizens resident in Ontario.
- Must hold a secondary school diploma.
- Must have received admission for fulltime attendance at a recognised university or college.

### **Application Process:**

Interested individuals are required to apply to the association by completing the prescribed application and providing the supporting information/documentation as follows:

- A copy of the high school transcript.
- Two letters of reference, one of which must be from the academic institution attended.
- An essay of no more than 300 words outlining why you should receive the award.
- A resume outlining your academic qualifications, work history and community involvement
- Proof of fulltime acceptance at a recognised university or community college, e.g., a letter from the institution.
