SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Purpose:

To encourage and assist youth from the Grenadian, Carriacouan and Petit Martinique community to pursue their educational goals at the University or College level.

To recognize academic efforts and community involvement.

Number and Value of Awards:

The value of scholarships awarded annually is \$1,000.00 each, to a maximum number of four (4) recipients. The scholarships are non-renewable and non-transferable. The scholarships are to be used for any full course of study, leading to a Diploma or first Degree.

Where tenable:

These awards are tenable at any recognized university or community college.

Eligibility:

Eligible recipients include:

Children whose parents, guardians, grandparents are of Grenadian, Carriacouan or Petit Martinique (hereinafter referred to as GC&PM) descent.

Qualifications and Obligations of Applicants:

- Must hold a Secondary School Diploma;
- Must be a first year student enrolled at or presently attending a University or College -
- Must submit proof of acceptance to University or College;

Selection of Scholarship Winners:

The Selection Committee, appointed by the Grenada Association (Toronto) and made up of members of the GC&PM community in Toronto and environs, will select candidates and the Grenada Association (Toronto) will administer the scholarship programme.

EVALUATION WILL BE BASED UPON:

- a copy of Academic transcript.
- Two letters of reference, one from the academic institution attended.
- An essay of no more than 500 words entitled "**Why I should receive an award.**"
The essay should outline not only your academic achievements, but any volunteer activities and leadership roles you have assumed.

Obligation of winners:

Award winners must:

- be a recipient of a letter of admission to a first year programme, or be continuing first year of university or college.
- Pursue at least one full year of study.
- Submit to the Grenada Association (within a month of selection for scholarship) confirmation of admission to the institution.
- Be prepared to participate in future award ceremonies and serve as role models for others in the GC&PM community.

Conditions of Payment:

A cheque for the full value of the scholarship will only be issued upon receipt of proof of enrollment for the calendar year.
